**An Anti-Tech Talk**

This talk by Mr. Gray addresses the human element and explains using real life examples the methods by which attackers are gaining information about victims in order to perform successful cyber-attacks. The flow of this talk begins with open source intelligence gathering techniques, then transitions into social engineering methods to bait victims into the schemes.

After demonstrating various ways to gain the trust of the victim and getting them to provide the data or performing the action, the talk finishes with a demonstration of what could happen and how it could affect the network that the victim is connected to. After this talk, the audience should have a better understanding of who, what, and how attackers exploit people and in what areas awareness should be raised in to protect the organization.
